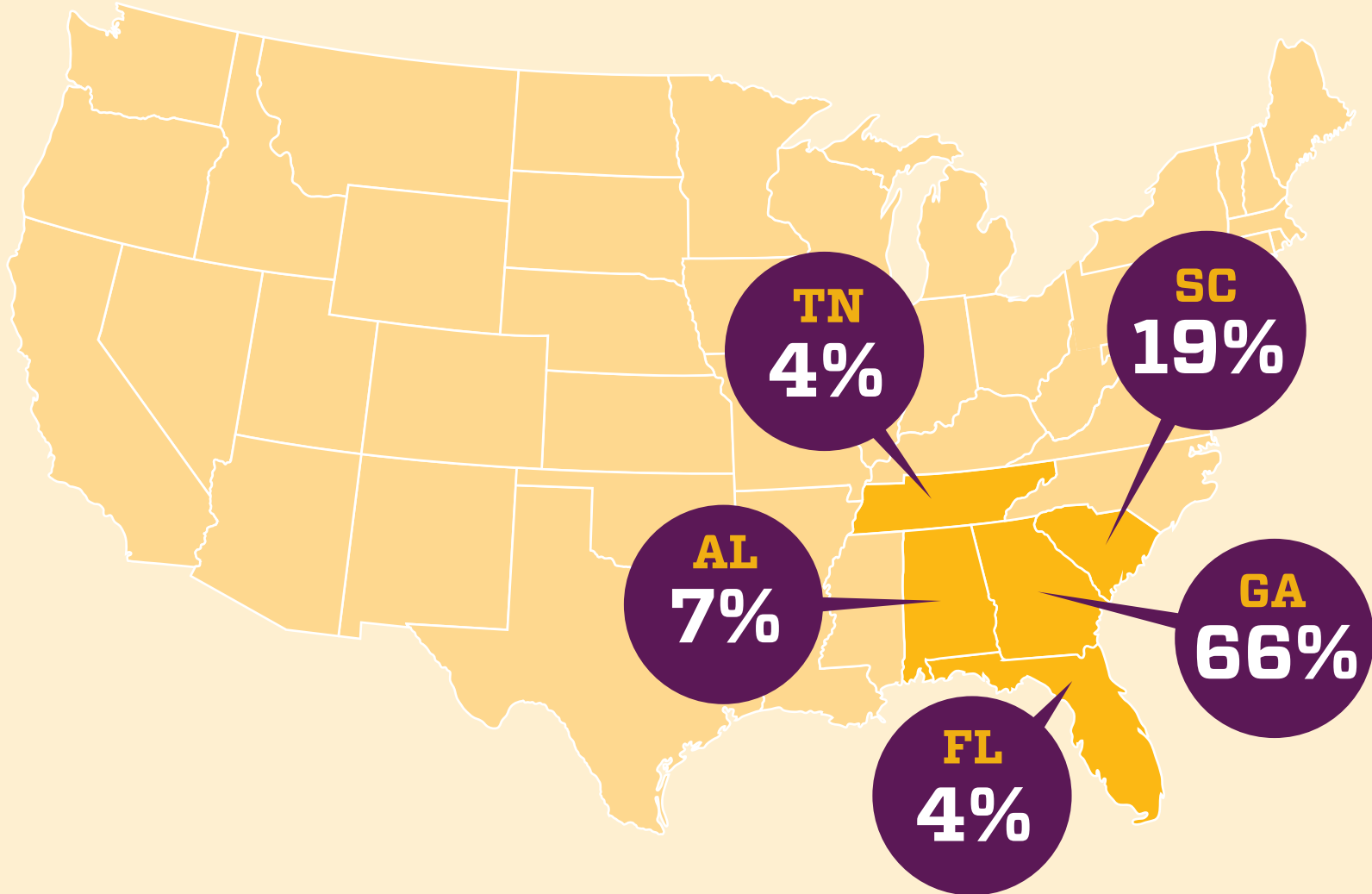

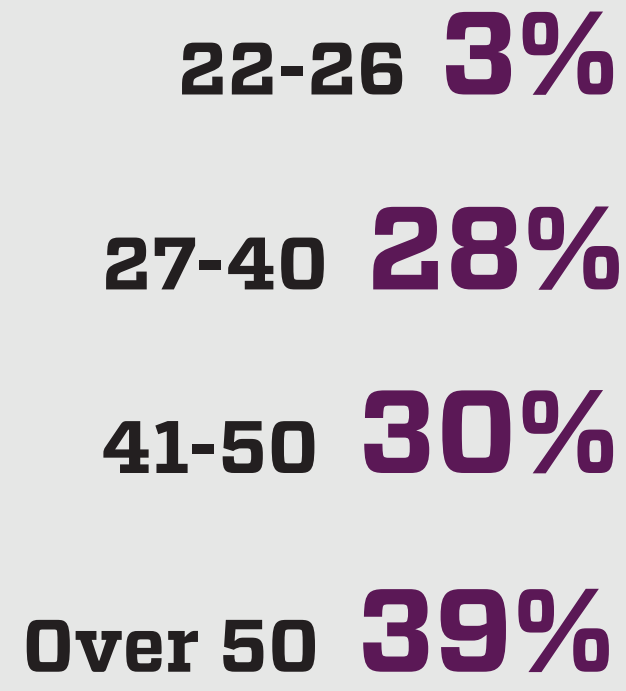

Age Group



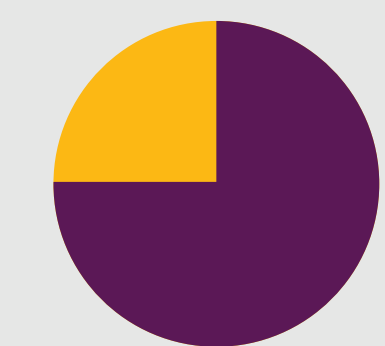

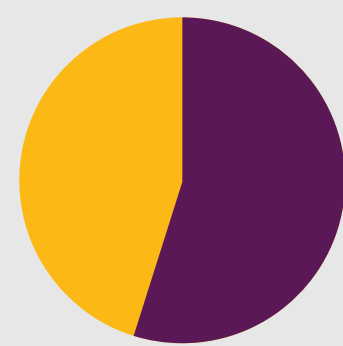
75% of learners had their professional education financed entirely by their employer.
