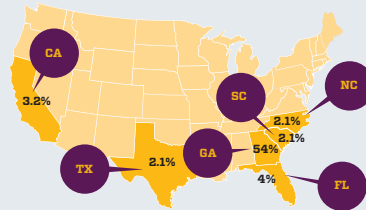


# Supply Chain and Logistics at a Glance

## » LEARNERS REPRESENT THESE TOP SIX STATES

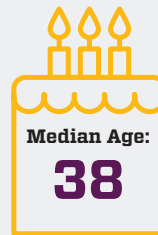


## » TOP THREE COURSES IN 2019

## » PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- GTPE served **587 adult learners** with professional education in Supply Chain and Logistics.
- GTPE offers **8 certificate programs and 40+ courses** in supply chain and logistics to meet the needs of workers in this field at all stages of their careers - from entry level to director level.
- In addition to adult learners, **135 high school students** took courses in the Logistics Education and Pathways (LEAP) program. LEAP is a fast-track online certificate program that prepares participants to compete for jobs in high-growth careers in supply chain and logistics.

## » TOP INDUSTRIES SEEKING SUPPLY CHAIN AND LOGISTICS SKILLS

- Retail Trade: **25%**
- Manufacturing: **15%**
- Transportation and Warehousing: **13%**
- Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services: **8%**
- Accommodation and Food Services: **6%**
- Health Care and Social Assistance: **5%**
- Finance and Insurance: **4%**
- Public Administration: **4%**

## » JOB POSTINGS

- Job postings grew **37%** from 57,693 in 2015 to 78,910 in 2018
- **32% of Supply Chain and Logistics jobs** posted in 2019 are entry level jobs
- **72% of jobs posted** specify a bachelor's degree, 4% prefer master's degree or higher
